

Titahi Bay Bouldering



Titahi Bay Bouldering- I have climbed possibly 10-15 new problems at Titahi bay on the odd trips there over the last year or so, finally got round to writing some of them up. There are quite a few more but not had the chance to document them yet. (I will do soon as I find time)

One worth mentioning is –**Cangrejo V6** as it's a great problem is on page 38 of the Wellington Rock Guide. It's a crab like, roof traverse of the cave roof. Sit start left hand side, pull up to roof then, hand slaps and heel hooks until you reach the other side, cut loose and swing round to seaward face, use big handholds and pull up on top of roof (need a good spotter here). Descent left hand side.

I don't think any of these have been climbed before, but sorry if they have.

Adam Power on 'Dreaming of Ysgo'



Scoopy Doo- V2- start in the obvious scoop just right of the seaward face of the boulder, pull up to the flake and use just this to pull to easier holds above.

Dreaming of Ysgo- V4/5- start in right hand scoop, pull to arête above scoop, then climb the arête and face. (sticking more to the face is harder)

Power Shells- V7/8 – pull on micro crimps on the short wall at the back of the boulder, up to the ledge, the mantke to finish. (very hard start)

Rocky-Bay Entrance Boulder- Just as you walk into Shelley bay from the Southern end this boulder is tucked away to the left of the entrance.



Sit start, under-cling on flake, slap round arête,

Slap and tickle- V3
